### **Safety to and from School**

Safety of our children is the most important thing to us all. Please can we all keep making sure that children are safe when travelling to and from school in cars or vans and are always wearing a seat belt and, where appropriate, using a properly-fitted car seat. We know that everyone wants to keep children safe at all times – it is what we all aim for. However, school has received reports which suggest that perhaps some children are travelling without seat belts or appropriate car seats – just to remind you that this is not only dangerous, but also illegal. Like you, we would hate any of our families to get hurt, particularly if it could be avoided. As always, should you see any child at risk, we urge you to contact the police. As you know, the use of car seats for certain children, and the wearing of seatbelts by all, are legal requirements.

We are lucky that traffic wardens randomly patrol the area near to school to keep us safe. With this in mind, we remind you not to stop on the double yellow lines or zig zags when dropping children off or collecting them, as this can contribute to accidents. These road markings are there to keep children and adults safe, therefore, parking on these is putting people at risk.

We are always proud to hear so many wonderful stories of our children's behaviour and manners when walking to and from school and thank you for continuing to support them with this.
