Keeping warm!

As we say a reluctant goodbye to the summer and the cold weather creeps in, we ask that all children bring a coat to school, to wear at playtime and lunchtime. Also, as it becomes appropriate, please can you ensure that your child/children have hats and gloves to keep them warm, when they are on the playground. Children that do not have suitable outdoor clothing, will not, as the weather becomes colder, be allowed to have an outdoor playtime and will have to remain inside at break and lunch times. Thank you for your help in keeping our Great Wood children warm and cosy.



At this time of year, it's important to Be Bright and Be Seen when you are out and about near roads.

BE BRIGHT – wear fluorescent or brightly coloured clothing when walking to and from school – it shows up well in daylight and at dusk.

REFLECTIVE – When it's dark outside, wear reflective clothing to be seen in car headlights. Reflective vests, sashes or wristbands work well.

IMPROVE – improve your visibility with accessories, clip on reflectors, armbands and stickers added to your coat or bag are a great way to improve your visibility.

GREEN CROSS CODE – always choose routes and crossing places that are well lit and remember to use the Green Cross Code.

HEADLIGHTS – if you like to cycle, it's the law to have clean and working headlights on your bike at night (white at the front, red at the back) as well as a rear reflector. It's good to fit spoke reflectors too.


Please ensure that you return your Academy Photographs to school by the close of the school day on **Monday 18th November.** We are unfortunately unable to process any orders received after this date.

We discussed the following items:

Parking discussion

The group agreed there are parking options at Christ Church Hall, Great Wood Hall and the White Hart Public House. Yet, a minority of parents and carers continue to park illegally on Vicarage Road. It was agreed to purchase traffic cones and place them at key points to discourage people from endangering our children by reckless parking.

Wrap-ground-care provision

Parents thanked Jean and Gina for the excellent service they are providing and the group agreed the provision is a school asset. The club is to trial offering hot food for those children/parents that require it – more details to follow.

Homework

The group held a discussion on the subject of homework and it was agreed the current amount and frequency was acceptable. Some parents required additional information in some areas specifically e-learning. School will run a elearning workshop in the new year – more details to follow.
