Dear parent/carer,

Proposed Waiting Restriction – Holt Lane, Kingsley.

We hope that you are well.

School have received a letter from Staffordshire County Council's Divisional Highways Programme, advising that representation has been made to the local County Councillor to support the implementation of waiting restrictions along Holt Lane (the road upon which school is situated).

The letter advises that the proposal is following safety concerns raised by members of the public regarding on-street parking along Holt Lane at the beginning and end of the school day, around our lovely school. As you know, parking safely is something which school regularly write about and encourage in our newsletters.

The proposal is for double yellow lines and single yellow lines (restricted parking Mon-Fri 08:30-09:30 and 14:30-15:30) which will cover at least one side of the road (and in some parts, both sides), for much of the area between the junction of Holt Lane and Dovedale Road, towards the entrance to Haste Hill Avenue. There would be parking on one side of the road for a small number of vehicles prior to the bend (towards the front of school) and for a small stretch near to the car park exit.

As you would expect, the proposal includes double yellow lines on both sides of the road where it bends around the corner.

Zig zags remain as areas where there should be <u>no stopping</u> so children are kept safe.
