Dear parents / carers,

The children have also been truly incredible with maintaining our bubbles, catching coughs / sneezes and constantly washing and sanitizing their hands. They have all bounced back brilliantly and come into school really happy and keen to learn.

I would also publically like to thank all the staff at school who have dealt with the ever changing guidance and risk assessments that have been dropped on them, usually hours before school opens, cleaning and sanitising chairs, tables and hot spots, planning and delivering home learning with little notice and doing their best to keep us all safe.
