We have put together a 'Frequently asked questions' letter to provide you with lots of useful information about your child's learning experience in Reception.

Home Times

You will have noticed home time is a busy time, to help us to get the children out to you a little quicker and more safely please can you make your way to the gate.

PE Days

Our PE days are Monday and Thursday.

Library Books

Your child will start to bring home a library book each week. These books are not always matched to their reading level but are aimed to be 'reading for pleasure' ideally sharing the book with an adult. Our library day will be a <u>Wednesday</u>.

Reading Folders

You will find a letter explaining how the reading folder works in your child's folder. We will be sending a letter home with the dates for phonics workshops in the next few weeks.

Learning takes place both at home and at school, it is really important therefore that we hear all about all your child's wonderful achievements at home. Please tell us about what your child has done at home which has amazed you. We can send more super star's home as you require them. The super stars can be completed at any point in the year and can include photos.

Snacks

Please let us know if you don't want your child to purchase warm morning snacks from school or if there is something in particular they can't have. Your child is welcome to bring their own morning snack. We provide the children with fruit and milk in the afternoon.
