Class 2 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Overview.

Welcome back, we hope you have had a wonderful break.

Below is a brief outline of the curriculum areas, which we will be focusing upon in class throughout the next half term in Class 2.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

English:	Wisp by Zana Fraillon. Writing Outcome – Fiction: First Person Recount.
Guided Reading:	Ariki and the Island of Wonders by Nicola Davies.
Maths:	Addition & Subtraction (Money). Geometry – Properties of Shapes. Number – Multiplication & Division. Number – Fractions. Measurement – Length.
Computing:	We are Programmers.
R.E./P.S.H.E.:	How do Christians remember Jesus' last supper?/ Rights and Respect.
Art:	European Arts and Artists.
History:	Roman Britain.
Science:	Teeth and Eating.
Music:	Recorder Tuition, Basic Notation.
P.E.:	Alternative Sports & Tag Rugby.
Spanish:	La fecha (The Date).

During the Autumn Term, Class 2 will have P.E. on a **Thursday** and **Friday**. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate P.E. kit (including footwear) in school on these days, including an outdoor kit.

Class Two will also have Swimming on a **Tuesday** afternoon (beginning 20th February 2024).





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Homework this term will consist of spellings practice (a paper copy has been sent and they can also be viewed on our website), **daily reading practice (5 times a week)** of between 10 and 20 minutes a day and times tables practice through TT Rockstars **at least three times a week.** With the daily reading practice, an adult signature is requested to show that pupils have read at home as part of their homework.

Today, children have received a homework mind map, where there are different types of activities pupils can choose to complete on a weekly basis (one task, per week please). This should be completed in their homework book and handed in every Wednesday to be checked.
