Re: Reception Curriculum Update - Spring Term (2nd Half)

As your child continues their learning journey we wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing on in class.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

Curriculum Area	Focus
English	During this half term our work will focus on the text I'm going to eat this ant by Chris Naylor-Ballesteros.
	Please avoid reading this book to your child at home, we do lots of work on prediction/ discussion about what will happen next during this unit, thank you.
	We will also explore other texts such as Flashlight by Lizi Boyd, Guess who's in the trees/grass/sand by Camilla Bedoyere, Bugs A-Z By Caroline Lawton
	Towards the end of the half term we will study a poetry unit focused on Creepy Crawlies.
Phonics	We will be embedding the Set 1 sounds with a greater emphasis on segmenting and blending to read and write.
Maths	During this half term we will focus on: Number - Counting & recognising numbers
	Measure - Weight & Time
	Number - Adding & Subtracting (Subtracting)
Theme	The Great Outdoors
Personal, Social and Emotional	This half term we will focus on the theme 'Me and my world'. The unit will focus on how families are all different but special, families in different

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	countries, people who help us and what jobs the children might like to do in the future.
Understanding the World	We will explore the following themes: Growing plants Different types of Flowers How the local area has changed The season of spring Trees We are hoping to visit the forest school site at our sister school to support our learning.
Expressive Arts	We will explore the following themes through art, music and dance. Exploring colour Creating natural structures using both natural and man-made objects Movement & dance – spring themed Easter celebrations & art We will also take part in a weekly music lesson led by Mrs Whiteley.
Physical Development	We will focus on body shape development. Our PE sessions will be led by ASM.
Religious Education	This half term we will focus on the theme Why do we put a cross in an Easter garden? We will explore the events of Lent and Easter.

Our P.E. days this term are Monday and Thursday.

Our library book day this term is **Wednesday**.

Please ensure your child brings their reading folder to school every day.
