Re: Reception Curriculum Update - Summer Term (2nd Half)

As your child continues their learning journey we wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing on in class.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

Curriculum Area	Focus
English	During this half term our work will focus on the text 'Silly Doggy!' by Adam Stower. The purpose of this half terms text is to develop the children's ability to retell the story.
	Please avoid reading this book to your child at home until we have completed the unit, we do lots of work on prediction/ discussion about what will happen next during this unit, thank you.
	We will also explore other texts about animals, including a range of non-fiction texts.
	Towards the end of the half term we will study a poetry unit focused on Nature poems.
Phonics	We will be introducing the Set 2 sounds. We will continue to develop the children's skills in segmenting and blending when reading and writing.
Maths	During this half term we will focus on: Measure – Time, Money and space
	Number – Solving problems, counting and recognising numbers to 20.
Theme	Fun at the seaside
Personal, Social and Emotional	This half term we will focus on the theme 'Reach for the stars'. The unit will focus on: Understanding the importance of concentrating, developing concentration skills.
