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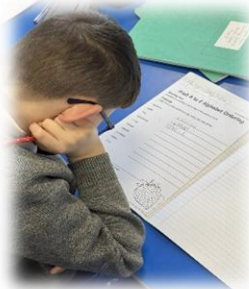
## Green Class

It's been a great start to the year for Green Class.

From the launch of our English text, 'When the Giant Stirred' to telling the time in Maths, the children have shown great perseverance when tackling tricky concepts and have worked well in small groups.

In History, we have started to learn about the Ancient Egyptians. This week, the children have enjoyed ordering significant events on a timeline.

In Science, we have started looking at solids, liquids and gases. We have discussed and identified a solid, liquid and gas before working in small groups to demonstrate the movement of particles for each one.



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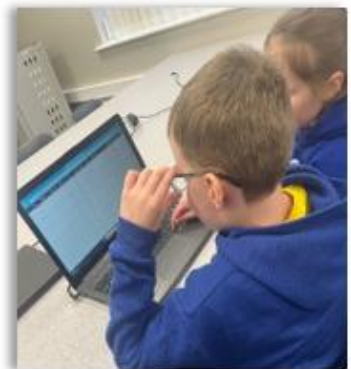
## Indigo Class

Welcome back and Happy New Year from Indigo class! The children have returned to school eager to learn and to show off their talents across all areas of learning.

We have introduced our new text, 'Kai and the Monkey King'. The children have made predictions on the story and continue to develop their inference skills, as they consider how actions help us understand how a character is feeling.

In Maths, we have worked on both mental and written methods for subtraction and mental and written methods for adding and subtracting decimals. Year 4 children worked methodically to estimate, work out calculations and complete the inverse operation. Year 5 focused on applying their place value knowledge when working with decimal calculations.

We have investigated weather in Computing, working in pairs to research and record weather temperatures across the world. We also enjoyed a dance session during PE time which focused on the Great Wall of China. This linked wonderfully to our English learning. The children had lots of fun working in groups to act out and synchronise building movements.



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## Violet Class

Violet Class have had a super start to the Spring term and are already working their socks off! So far, we have explored our respiratory systems and looked at the capacity of our lungs to hold air, investigated places we import bottled water and food from using the computers, and started to create our own dance routines in our PE lessons. What a start!



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
