

# Red Class Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2025





## RE

What do Hindu's believe? Our new topic will allow us to explore a new faith and compare it to Christianity and other world faiths. We will look at important religious festivals, celebrations, traditions and songs.



#### Maths

This term we are focusing on; number bonds to 10. This means learning all of the pairs of numbers that make a number to 10. We are also deepening our understanding of numbers through the composition of all numbers within 10.

We shall be learning to add and subtract using counting backwards and forwards using a number line and then within our heads. Then applying these methods into real life contexts and problems.

We shall be learning how to use standard units to measure for example; capacity using litres, length using centimetres and weight using grams.



## **English**

Our new text The Naughty Bus is all about a bus journey through a busy house. The text will be a great opportunity to look at simple story retelling as well as sequencing g the main events.

We will work on improving our writing through applying our known

phonic sounds to spell and write sentences.



# **Understanding of the world**

Our very suitable topic, Frozen, is all about melting and freezing this term. We shall be investigating materials to prevent melting, ingredients to speed up melting as well as the best conditions for freezing. We will look at countries around the world where the weather is very cold and learn more about how the seasons and weather changes in these places.



## **Spanish**

In Red Class over this half term we will continuing to learn nursery rhymes, favourite songs and welcome words with Mr Day.



#### Music

In our music lessons we will be investigating high and low sounds through body movements and animal sounds. As well as also exploring different sounds made by everyday objects and how our voices can change when singing.



#### **PSED**

This term we are learning about 'Being Safe'. This unit helps us to understand how to keep ourselves safe in our work, play and on the internet.



# **Expressive Art and Design**

We are finding out about art this term that depicts great explorations through history. We shall be learning new and exciting art techniques to create artwork in the style of famous artists.



## <u>PE</u>

Our PE lessons for this term will be taken by the specialist teachers ASM and Mrs Hill. We are learning about gymnastics this term. This will include developing our skills when balancing, jumping, rolling and sequencing.
