Attendance to week ending 4th April 2025:


Reception/Year 1 - 96.77% Years 2 & 3 - 96.48% Year 4 - 97.19% Years 5 & 6 - 95.39%

School attendance for the week: 94.47%


Each week, Woody our attendance bear, gets to spend the week with the class who has had the best attendance. I wonder where Woody will be next week!


